

South Korean pianist Sun Min Kim serves as Coordinator of Keyboard Studies and Assistant Professor of Music at Denison University. He made his debut with the Ulsan Symphony Orchestra at age 13, performing Grieg's Piano Concerto. He has been a prizewinner of national and international competitions such as the Maria Canals International Piano Competition, MTNA, and International Crescendo Music Awards. As a laureate of various awards, he debuted at Carnegie Hall's Weill Recital Hall, Merkin Concert Hall, and other prestigious venues across the United States and abroad.
